Annual Scholarship Application

Purpose:

This \$500 scholarship is designed to provide the opportunity to a promising young person who without financial assistance would find it difficult to further their education in the field of camping, recreation, outdoor education, or related field. Both the ability to succeed and financial need are emphasized in the selection of recipients. Primary consideration will be given to those whose academic performance is high and who have demonstrated personal qualities of initiative, leadership, and professional promise.

Eligibility:

- Must be sponsored by a current member of the Connecticut Camping Association.
- The applicant must be a high school senior or graduate.
- Reside in the United States.
- Must be or have been involved in an organized camping experience.

Selection:

The Connecticut Camping Association's Scholarship Committee will make the selection of scholarship winner. Applications will be judged on the following basis:

Camp Participation.....	15%
Scholastic Standing.....	20%
Financial Need.....	30%
Personal Essay.....	20%
References.....	15%

Application Procedure:

1. Fill out Application completely and carefully as instructed
2. The attached three reference forms must be completed and mailed to the address on the reference form. No application will be considered without 3 completed reference forms.
3. Write your own personal letter, addressed to the Bernie Moore/ CCA Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship Closing Date: Labor Day – First Monday in September.

Scholarship Presentation: The scholarship will be awarded at the Connecticut Camping Association's Annual Meeting in December. Award recipients need to be present.
